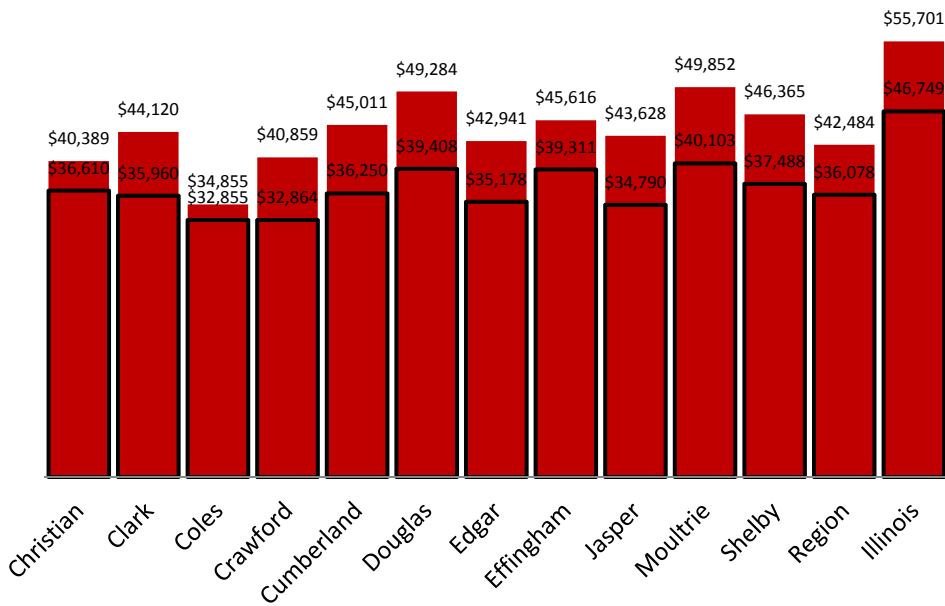

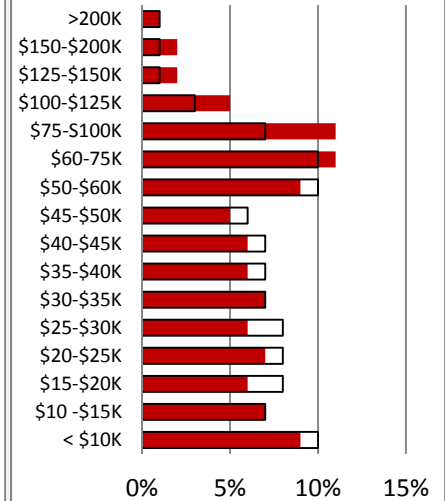
Median Household Income 2000, 2010

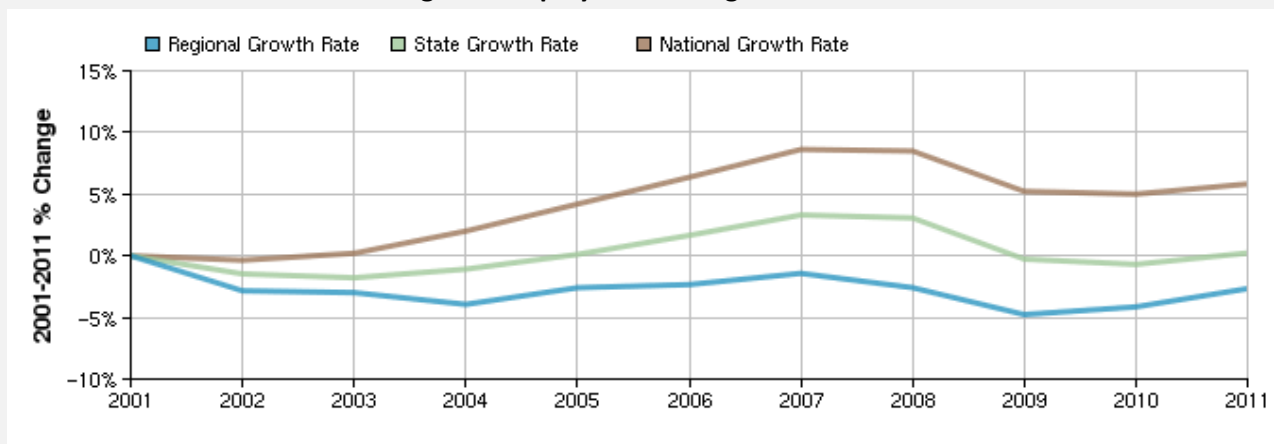
